On approval, Peter Horobin Saddlery will send you a replied postage sticker which includes the parcel to be registered and insured at the cost of \$45.00 which needs to be paid over the phone by credit card. This will provide you the convenience of postage.

Duration

We provide allow 90 days to sell your saddle. If your saddle is not sold within this time period, we will give you a call to asses the situation and return the saddle to you at your cost. You will receive a solid, good quality box with your saddle inside for the assistance in your resale to a customer. Alternatively if we feel your saddle still has potential then we can discuss the price point and lower it for the opportunity to sell for another 30 days.

Pricing

You may have an idea of how much you want for your saddle, and we would like to know. Some people prefer to take less and have a saddle sell quickly, while others prefer a possible longer wait to try and get as much as possible. We always price according to the market value but of course we want you to be happy with the pricing as well. If there is a specific amount of money you want to receive for the saddle, please list it in the form. If you leave this blank, we will assume you would like some advice, and will call you to discuss.

Safety Checks

Please note that Peter Horobin Saddlery does check every saddle that is shipped into our store for broken/twisted trees, thinning or cracked billets, loose stitching and other possible defects that would make the saddle unsafe. In the event that your saddle has a problem that can be fixed, we will call you to see if you would like to have it repaired and quote you on the costs involved for these repairs. If the saddle is unsafe and can not be repaired it will be returned to you at your expense. You are always welcome to call or email to receive a repair quote prior to sending your saddle in to us.

Trade-Ins

We will do our very best to give you the highest possible price for your trade in on a new Peter Horobin saddle. Please tick the box if you wish to trade in and one of our knowledgeable staff members will be in contact.

Conditions of Trade
